
### Is Homeschooling Legal?

There are several legal options: (1) establishing a private school (Private School Affidavit, PSA); (2) using a private satellite program (PSP); (3) using a public school program (a charter school or a public independent study program [ISP]); and (4) tutoring with a current California credential. Sometimes people imagine there may be problems when the parent becomes the teacher. In reality, parents become trusted







facilitators, and children become competent and self-motivated learners.
